A special call meeting will be held on January 23rd at 5:00 p.m. He stated that the town will borrow \$1.6 million and net \$1.5 million with an interest rate of 3.9% on a 20-year issue and the annual payments will vary between \$113,000 and \$117,000. Mayor Bunt stated this will be paid back with new revenues.
